for the building of the first Catholic church, with Father Rossi in charge, and laid out a general merchandise store operated by Bodega's McCaughev brothers.

Levi Slusser arrived in

Russian River township, built a spacious home. Much of Slusser land was used as military airfield in World War II. and later as Sonoma County Airport north of Santa Rosa.

The first Russian River water carnival was held.
