If you are a creditor or a contingent creditor of the decedent, you must file your claim with the court and mail a copy to the personal representative appointed by the court within the later of either (1) four months from the date of first issuance of letters to a general personal representative, as defined in section 58(b) of the California Probate Code, or (2) 60 days from the date of mailing or personal delivery to you of a notice under section 9052 of the California Probate Code.

Other California statutes and legal authority may affect your rights as a creditor. You may want to consult with an attorney knowledgeable in California law.

You may examine the file kept by the court. If you are a person interested in the estate, you may file with the court a formal Request for Special Notice (FORM DE-154) of the filing of an inventory and appraisal of estate assets or of any petition or account as provided in Probate Code §1250. A Request for Special Notice form is available from the court clerk.

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**INITIAL PUBLIC NOTICE SONOMA COUNTY FLOOD ELEVATION PROJECT COUNTY OF SONOMA DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY SERVICES**

FMA-PJ-09-CA-2013-002  
The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) proposes to provide Federal financial assistance under the Flood Mitigation Assistance program to the County of Sonoma Department of Emergency Services (Subapplicant), through the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services, for the Sonoma County Flood Elevation Project (proposed action). Pursuant to Executive Order (EO) 11988 (Floodplain Management), EO 11990 (Protection of Wetlands), and FEMA's implementing regulations at Title 44 Code of Federal Regulations Part 9, FEMA hereby provides interested parties with a notice of its intent to carry out an action that will affect floodplains and that may affect wetlands.

The purpose of the proposed action is to prevent repeated flooding of and flood-related damage to 12 private residential structures in Sonoma County. The proposed action would consist of elevating each structure a minimum of 12 inches above the Base Flood Elevation (BFE) or 100-year flood level.

The proposed improvements would be in or near the communities of Forestville, Guerneville, and Monte Rio, California, in the lower Russian River area. All structures are located in the Special Flood Hazard Area Zone AE, an area with a 1-percent chance of flooding every year, as indicated on the Sonoma County, California, and Incorporated Areas Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs), Map Numbers 06097C0657E, 06097C0545E,

06097C0677E, and 2452080606C, effective date December 2, 2008. Flood zones shown on FIRMs are determined using detailed methods and established BFEs.

Potential wetlands have been identified adjacent to some of the structures. Temporary access and construction staging areas may occur in these wetlands to implement the proposed action.

Maps of the project areas and their locations within the floodplain are available for public inspection. Parties interested in receiving a copy of the maps should contact the FEMA Region IX Environmental Officer at the contact information provided below.

Anteo, a trotting stallion owned by breeder Isaac DeTurk, won a race and became a valuable stud.

Sonoma was reincorporated as a city.

Cloverdale got its first phone, located in a bakery.

Charles Bolen, also known as stagecoach robber Black Bart, was captured, and served 4 years in San Quentin.
