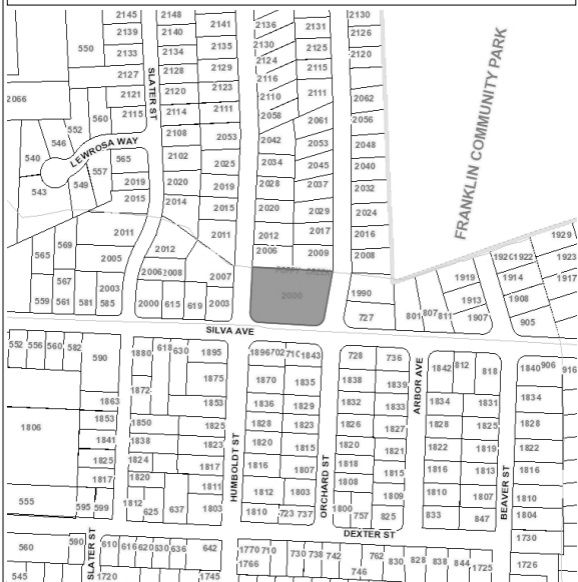

In 1882

Stagecoach driver "Wash" Gilham died in the saddle.

Influential Seventh Day Adventist Church activist Ellen G. White helped create Healdsburg Adventist College.

Natale Bacigalupi arrived in Santa Rosa, becoming the unofficial mayor of "Little Italy." He ran a grocery store and made "seed money" loans to immigrants. The Traverso and Arrigoni families started as clerks in his store.

Korbel began winemaking in west county, with an output of 20,000 to 30,000 gallons a year.
