NOTICE INVITING BIDS

1. Sonoma County Junior College District ("Owner"), will accept sealed bids for the Lawrence A. Bertolini Student Services Center Cleaning of the Open Plenum Project ("Project"), by or before 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, December 3, 2015, at 2:00:00 p.m., at its Purchasing Department office, located in Bailey Hall, 1501 Mendocino Ave., Santa Rosa, California, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any non-substantive irregularities.
2. This Project requires a valid California contractor's license for the following classification(s): Hazardous Materials.
3. Each bid must conform and be fully responsive to this invitation, the plans and scope of work and all other documents comprising the pertinent contract documents. The contract documents are available to contractors by completing a Request to Download form and submitting it to the District Purchasing office via fax to 707-527-4870 or as an email attachment to dmoore@santarosa.edu. Contractors will then be provided the instructions to download the contract documents. The Purchasing Department telephone number is 707-527-4422. Only contractors that submit the Request to Download form will be included on the Plan Holder's list. The documents are also available for examination at the office of the Purchasing Director, Bailey Hall, 1501 Mendocino Ave., Santa Rosa, County of Sonoma, California, and may be obtained by Contractors licensed by the California State Contractors' License Bureau. The contract documents are also available for review at the local Builder Exchanges.
4. Each bid must be submitted using the Bid Proposal Form provided with the Contract Documents. Each Bid Proposal must be accompanied by bid security of ten percent (10%) of the maximum bid amount, in the form of a cashier's or certified check made payable to Owner, or a bid bond executed by a surety licensed to do business in the State of California on the Bid Bond form included with the Contract Documents. The bid security shall guarantee that upon award of the bid, the bidder shall execute the contract and submit payment and performance bonds and insurance certificates as required by the Contract Documents within ten (10) days following notice of award of the Contract.
5. This Project is subject to the prevailing wage requirements applicable to the locality in which the Work is to be performed for each craft, classification or type of worker needed to perform the Work, including employer payments for health and welfare, pension, vacation, apprenticeship and similar purposes. These prevailing rates are available online at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR>. Each Contractor and Subcontractor must pay no less than the specified rates to all workers employed to work on the Project. The schedule of per diem wages is based upon a working day of eight (8) hours. The rate for holiday and overtime work shall be at least time and one-half.
6. Performance and payment bonds will be required of the successful bidder.
7. The substitution of appropriate securities in lieu of retention amounts from progress payments is permitted in accordance with Public Contract Code Section 22300.
8. Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 4104 each Bid Proposal must include the name and location of the place of business of each subcontractor who shall perform work or service or fabricate or install work for the prime contractor in excess of one-half of one percent (1/2 of 1%) of the bid price, or \$10,000, whichever is greater, using the Subcontractor List form included with the Contract Documents.
9. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the date set for the opening for bids except as provided pursuant to Public Contract Code Sections 5100 et seq.
10. Additional information is provided in the Instructions and Information for Bidders, which should be carefully reviewed by all bidders prior to submitting a Bid Proposal.
11. This Contract is subject to a labor compliance program pursuant to subdivision (b) of Section 1771.5 of the Labor Code.
12. A mandatory bidders' conference will be held on Monday, November 17, 2014, at 2:00 p.m., beginning at the southeast entrance to the Bertolini Student Center 1501 Mendocino Ave., Santa Rosa, California for the purpose of acquainting all prospective bidders with the bid documents and the Worksite. A bidder who fails to attend a mandatory bidders' conference may be disqualified from bidding.

The independent administration authority will be granted unless an interested person files an objection to the petition and shows good cause why the court should not grant the authority.

If you object to the granting of the petition, you should appear at the hearing and state your objections or file written objections with the court before the hearing. Your appearance may be in person or by your attorney.

If you are a creditor or a contingent creditor of the decedent, you must file your claim with the court and mail a copy to the personal representative appointed by the court within the later of either (1) four months from the date of first issuance of letters to a general personal representative, as defined in section 58(b) of the California Probate Code, or (2) 60 days from the date of mailing or personal delivery to you of a notice under section 9052 of the California Probate Code.

Other California statutes and legal authority may affect your rights as a creditor. You may want to consult with an attorney knowledgeable in California law.

You may examine the file kept by the court. If you are a person interested in the estate, you may file with the court a formal Request for Special Notice (FORM DE-154) of the filing of an inventory and appraisal of estate assets or of any petition or account as provided in Probate Code §1250. A Request for Special Notice form is available from the court clerk.
