## SONOMA COUNTY HISTORY

### In 1905

The "Battle of Sebastopol Avenue" in Santa Rosa pitted steam train supporters against backers of the new electric train. Hundreds of backers for both sides sought to dominate in the March 1st showdown as thousands of spectators watched.

After court intervention, the electric line was allowed over the crossing on March 2nd.

Santa Rosa street railways were converted to electricity.

Banker John P. Overton, son of "Boss" Overton, was mayor during the 1906 quake.

The world-famous author Jack London moved to Glen Ellen, bought the "Beauty Ranch," and experimented with innovative farming methods.

Santa Rosa pitcher Walter Nagle signed on with the Los Angeles Angels baseball team, starring for several years, and went on to a career as the Sonoma County Clerk and Chamber of Commerce Manager.

Healdsburg held its first water carnival.

Rural Free Delivery was established in Windsor, covering six square miles. W.C. Lindsay was the postmaster.
