SONOMA COUNTY HISTORY In the 1950s

Bill Kortum opened a veterinary practice; He led the drive to locate Sonoma State College in the Cotati/Rohnert Park area, later becoming a county supervisor and a leader in the statewide conservation movements, especially on the Sonoma coast. As Soviet-U.S. Cold War started to heat up, residents built backyard bomb shelters. Developer Hugh Coddling turned orchards into suburbs, building Town and Country, his first shopping center, and Montgomery Village. As a promotion, he built one home in the Montgomery Village area in less than 4 hours. Coddling Enterprises became the largest real estate firm north of San Francisco. In the new era of "bankers and developers," major names included Coddling, Henry Trione, Charles Reinking, J. Ralph Stone and Elie Destruel. Mortgage banker and financier Trione invested in timber and wine and contributed to community causes, including the creation of Anadel State Park and the Burbank Center for the Arts. He operated Geyser Peak Winery until 1998. Banker James B. Keegan served as a Santa Rosa School Board member and was a fund-raiser for many causes. Drive-in restaurants and drive-in movie theaters opened. Hardtop racers, led by Rod Zanoline, competed at tracks in Santa Rosa, Petaluma, and other bay area sites. W. C. (Bob) Trowbridge built his canoe rental fleet on the Russian River and reigned as "Mr. Democrat," building the influence of the party in the second half of the 20th century. War hero General Henry "Hap" Arnold died in mid-January.

SONOMA COUNTY HISTORY In 1846

Defying Mexican rule, American frontiersmen staged the Bear Flag revolt with an attack on the city of Sonoma. Mexican War begins, ending in victory for Americans; Sonoma remains a military post, manned by First New York volunteers. Donner Party wagon train trapped in Sierra snow amid charges of cannibalism. Some survivors settle in Sonoma County. Ernest Rufus received land grant from Mexican government, acquired 17,580 acres called Gualala Ranch on German Rancho. In 20th century, much of area turned into Sea Ranch resort development. Logging and shipping became major activities in the 19th century as mill products were sent south by schooners.

SONOMA COUNTY HISTORY In 1925

Sonoma County had 141 grammar schools, 7 high schools and 8,132 enrollees: Analy had 375; Cloverdale, 66; Geyserville, 56; Healdsburg, 282; Petaluma, 575; Santa Rosa 697 and Sonoma Valley, 156. Sebastopol insurance man, Republican Herbert Scudder, held a state assembly seat until 1940. To lure tourists, investors pledged money and built a new Hotel Petaluma; the Jewish Community Center opened in Petaluma. In the middle of Prohibition, Silvio Volpi took over the operation of historic Volpi's Italian Market on Washington Street in Petaluma; the restaurant and bar were still operated by the Volpi family. Sonoma's Joe Ryan, "terror of bootleggers," became sheriff but died of a heart attack in 1926. Panizzera family took over the Union Hotel in Occidental; the hotel closed in 1930 but the restaurant and saloon remained open and the Gonnella family took over operations.

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
